Guidelines

August 2024

1. Must attain
- 12 points in 3 year period for Level 1
 - 20 points in 3 year period for Level 2
 - 40 points in 3 year period for Level 3

Section B must include a minimum of 30% from either B1 or B2. Level 1 coaches may earn points for Section B & C activities, but it is not mandatory unless upgrading to Level 2.

2. Levels 2 & 3 must submit verification requests to the relevant Divisional National Coaching Director.

3. Verifications (Section A and C) will only be granted with documentary proof. A verification sign off by the State Director or Coaching Director/Coordinator will be accepted and for Section C a verification sign off by the Chief Judge will also be accepted.

4. Verifications of performance or representative status (Section B) will only be granted when signed by one of the following:

- State Divisional Director
- National Divisional Director
- State Divisional Coaching Director/Coordinator
- Divisional National Coaching Director

5. Payment of an administration fee **\$10.00** (GST incl.) for WAWA members and **\$68.00** (GST incl.) for non-members] which includes WAWA membership - cheques payable to Australian Waterski and Wakeboard Federation (AWWF).

6. Additional courses, seminars or duties may be considered for updating by the Divisional National Coaching Director prior to your involvement in the event.
