These activities must be completed to gain accreditation and must be within 12 months of one another:

All completed record sheets must be returned to WAWA office for endorsement.(admin@awwf.com.au)

All hours must be verified by a Level 1 or 2 Waterski Coach or an official of WAWA, such as a Chief Judge, Club President, etc. Where practical, at least one-third of these hours should be completed under the supervision of a qualified coach. The name of the official must be included next to their signature.
